- Entry fee is \$230/entry
- In addition to silage yields, samples will also be analyzed for quality traits.
- **This year we are once again requesting seeds to be treated with an insecticide such as Poncho or Cruiser at the 1250 rate. No soil insecticide will be used.**
- Please print or type entries(s) as you want them to appear in final print.
- There is no limit on number of entries. Use additional sheets if needed.
- Please denote experimental entries by placing an (X) after the product designation.
- Test will consist of 2-row plots, replicated 4 times.
- Plant population will be between 22-24,000 plants/acre.
- **Seed is due by January 31, 2006.**
- **We request hybrids in the 114-118 day maturity range.**
- Appropriate agronomic readings will be taken throughout the growing season.
- One pound of seed is needed for each entry to be planted.
- Please make sure packages are securely wrapped and labeled.
- If you cannot meet the deadline, please contact us. We may be able to include your hybrid(s) before final planting arrangements are made.
- **Entry forms for the Grain Sorghum Silage Test (Bushland, Texas) will be sent in March.**
