- This test will be conducted in the Castroville/Hondo Area only.
- In addition to agronomic data, food quality data such as color evaluation, test weight, density, hardness, specific gravity and cooking evaluations will be conducted by the Cereal Quality Lab, Texas A&M University.
- Print or type hybrids as you want them to appear in final print.
- **Please note that the entry fee has increased from \$150/entry/location to \$165/entry/location.**
- There is no limit to number of entries.
- Tests will consist of 4 replications - 2 row plots.
- Seed and entry forms are **due by January 31, 2006.**
- Please send 1 pound of seed.
- Indicate grain and cob color in the appropriate columns.
- Please denote experimentals by placing an (X) after hybrid designation.
