Corn hybrids or lines may be entered by name or experimental number. They are all labeled in the field by code. There is no limit to the number of entries. These are not harvested, but appropriate readings are taken by Dr. Greta Schuster, Plant Pathologist, West Texas A&M University, Canyon, Texas. Entry fee is \$55/entry. Seed and entry forms are due in College Station no later than April 18, 2006. It has been our policy that if infection levels are low in the field due to weather related problems, we will not re-test nor refund the entry fee for those entries. If you receive no data due to mismanagement on our part, then those entries will be re-tested at no charge

CORN HEAD SMUT

- The test will consist of one row, 20 feet long and three replications conducted on Texas A&M University Research and Extension Center at Halfway.
- Will be planted in an area where levels of infection have occurred. A susceptible check will be planted every other row.
- 400 seed per entry are desired.
- There is no limit on number of entries.
