A minimum of **200 grams** of seed per entry/per location is needed.

Shipped seed should be securely wrapped and clearly labeled.

Sorghum seed should be treated with a fungicide and protected with Concep, and Poncho or Cruiser seed treatment for insects. **All seed must be safened as an acetamide herbicide may be used.**
