

Texas Wheat Variety Survey 2022

Producers across the state are encouraged to participate in the annual Wheat Variety Survey. The survey, conducted by the USDA-NASS Southern Plains Region, establishes the most widely planted varieties across the various growing regions in the state. The 2020 survey showed the top five varieties planted in Texas were TAM 114, Gallagher, TAM 112, TAM 111 and TAM 204.

The results generated by the survey can help guide research and development efforts of new varieties, assist Extension agents in making variety recommendations and provide seed companies with updated information on variety acceptance and trends. Wheat farmers benefit by gaining access to variety popularity in their growing regions, which can aid in annual variety selection.

Data provided by Texas wheat producers is the foundation of this report and we appreciate all farmers participating in the survey. We look forward to an updated account of the most popular winter wheat varieties in Texas in 2022.
